


Library Legislative Day in Georgia

New Library License Plate

You can now apply for the new library license plate that supports Georgia's public libraries. To apply for a Georgia Center for the Book - Public Library license plate, simply go to your local tag office and pay a one-time application/manufacturing fee of \$25.00.

The annual cost thereafter will be \$25.00 plus the regular tag fee. 1,000 people in the state of Georgia must apply for the license plate before December 31, 2007 for it to be produced. A picture of the tag is posted in the library.

End of Year Report on Membership

As we enter the final quarter of the year, the 2007 Membership season closes. This has been a good year for the Friends. We finish up the year with a total of 221 members. Although this figure represents a loss of 62 from last year, it also shows a very loyal base of Friends: 62% of our members have renewed over the course of the year.

The breakdown of our member categories follows:-

Complimentary (Board members, government officials)	16
Lifetime Members	4
Junior (Age 12 and under)	1
Individual (11 new folks)	54
Family (10 new)	71
Patrons (4 new)	49
Donor	13
Sponsor (1 new)	13

As we approach 2008, we are faced with many new challenges. The State funds for all educational endeavors continue to be subjected to severe austerity programs. In addition, a recent ruling allowing school boards to eliminate funding for public libraries has resulted in a major loss of funds at our local level. We are very fortunate in that our County Commissioner has stepped up to the plate and filled in the gap for this year.

On a brighter note, we are anticipating passage of a new SPLOST measure which will (hopefully) include a provision for expansion of our beloved library. With this in mind, we have included an opportunity for you to direct additional funds specifically for the outfitting of this eagerly awaited expansion. (The SPLOST funding will help with the physical building but not the furniture and fixtures.) Please take a moment to explore this and other opportunities where you might be able to assist with an additional gift beyond your membership fee.

Our 2008 Membership Drive will officially kick off in December this year. But, if you would like to get a head start on the crowd, please take advantage of the opportunity to 're-up' by filling out the enclosed form. If your mailing address is different from your home's physical address, please do give us the mailing address so you may continue to enjoy our quarterly newsletters. By including your e-mail address, we can alert you to up-coming meetings which are open to all as well as special or emergency needs as they might arise. We do promise not to share your contact information outside our group.
